## Vehicle Bag

Your vehicle bag keeps supplies you might need during an emergency that occurs while you are on the road. Imagine being caught in a snowstorm, a major pileup on a highway, or a long line of slowly-moving evacuation traffic. Update supplies according to the season. Always keep your tank at least half full (or your electric car battery at least half charged).

## Year 'round:

## In winter, add the following:

|           | First aid kit                         |  |
|           | Jumper cables                         | Bike safety flag (that you can zip tie to your roof<br>rack or antenna in a snow storm to help people<br>find you) |
|           | Seatbelt cutter/window breaker tool   | Zip ties   |
|           | Foldable, reflective warning triangle |  |
